# Inclusion at the Afbb

At the moment there are about 2000 VET- Trainees in the 3 locations Dresden, Berlin and Cologne. Almost nobody has physical or mental difficulties. Theachers reported singular cases where the learning activities of individuals represented a challenge. Apart from the standard counselling activities for trainees there is no special needs support forseen at the Afbb.

# Supporting activities

Technical support: in case of physical problems Afbb provides technical support. For instance we had one case of a „hard of hearing“ trainee, who also was very slow at speaking and quite silent. Technical support was provided with a **microfone** and **hearing aid**. Teachers reported **no major problem** during the lessons. Trainee successfully completed the VET.

# Dyslexia and ADHS

- We had few cases of mental difficulties. In this cases most of the support was provided by **social and healthcare authorities**. Afbb supported the trainees with extra assignment.
- In one case we ask for a special needs support during examination.
- A central role is played by the **other trainees in the classroom** by not excluding individual or helping during the regular lessons

# Fields of interest:

Since we provide VET for kindergarten teacher, social care Afbb can contribute with insight from the teachers perspective on inclusion. Moreover, due to the actual situation with refugees results of the project can be useful for special programs and activities
